

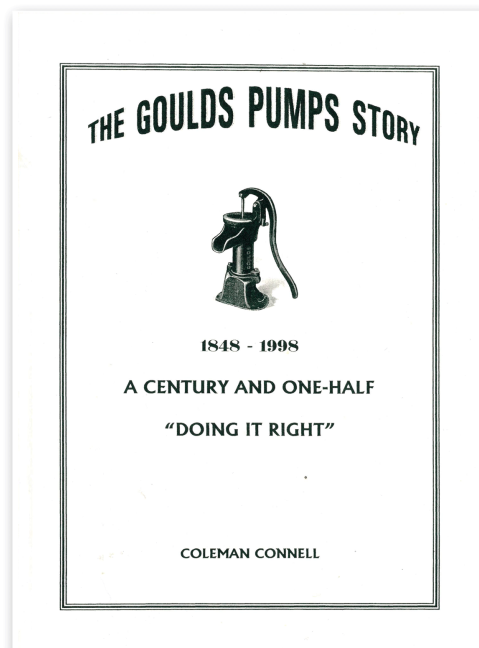


February 2021 Book:

"The Gould Pump Story" by Coleman Connell.

This month our Book is "The Gould's Pumps Story" by Coleman Connell. This book is history of Gould's Pumps from 1848-1998. 150 years!

It was just such a day, August 23, 1964, a warm and hazy Sunday Afternoon. A procession of people made its way into the First Presbyterian Church on lower Cayuga St. in the village of Seneca Falls, N.Y. In the Church where his grandfather Seabury Smith Gould had worshiped and sung in the choir, friends, business associates and employees gathered to pay their last respects to Norman Judd Gould, last of the Gould family to head Gould's Pumps, Inc. That same grandfather had founded the Company, in its present form, just a short walk away at a site now resting at the bottom of man-made Van Cleef Lake. Under the leadership of Norman Gould, the company once known as The Gould's Manufacturing Co., and before that by several names, had survived the most difficult of times. He had seen it evolve and grow from a water pump company to a manufacturer of centrifugal pumps for a multitude of applications-chemicals, paper stock, slurries, all form of waste, oil and gas and just about every substances which can be reduced to some semblance of liquid form.



And Gould's was and still is a major supplier of water pumps, for municipalities, private homes, irrigation and every sector of society dependent upon water.
